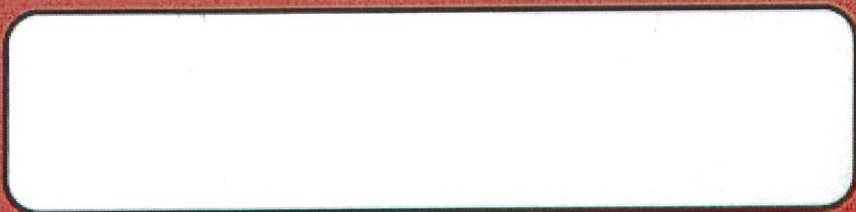

Create

Encourage

- ☞ Complete mastery of the use and application of voting and other political power tools to achieve the interests of African Americans, i.e. the initiation of a statewide voter education and registration drive;
 - ☞ Involvement in election campaigns of African American candidates;
 - ☞ Active involvement of African American youth through "learn by doing" methods, mentoring and other educational techniques that are implemented through our community-based organizations and churches

- ☞ Political accountability in which the African American community gives financial support to candidates and they, in turn when elected, promise to represent the interests of the African American community;
 - ☞ African American delegates and candidates account for themselves and their policies to functioning and duly authorized structures of IDAAC.
